Tithes to Prosperity

Romans 4:17 (KJV)¹⁷ (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, *even* God, who quickeneth the dead, and **calleth** those things which be not as though they were.

Genesis 8:22 (KJV)²² While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

Exodus 23:16 (KJV) ¹⁶ And the feast of harvest, the firstfruits of thy labours, which thou hast sown in the field: and the feast of ingathering, *which is* in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labours out of the field.

Leviticus 23:10 (KJV) ¹⁰ Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest: We are taught by this law to honour the Lord with our substance, and with the first-fruits of all our increase, <u>Prov 3:9</u>.

Harvest 47, boughs 3, branch 2, harvestman 1, harvest time 1 from <u><H7114></u> (qatsar); *severed*, *harvest* (as *reaped*), the crop, the time, the reaper, or figurative; also a *limb* (of a tree, or simply *foliage*) :- bough, branch, harvest (man)..

Reap 22, reaper 8, shortened 5, shorter 2, discouraged 1, lothed 1, straitened 1 primitive root; to *dock* off, i.e. *curtail* (transitive or intransitive, literal or figurative); especially to *har*-*vest* (grass or grain) :- \times at all, cut down, much discouraged, grieve, harvestman, lothe, mourn, reap (-er), (be, wax) short (-en, -er), straiten, trouble, vex. No Excues: Tithes to Prosperity

An **excuse** or **justification** is a form of <u>immunity</u> that must be dis*exculpation*. In this context, "to excuse" means to grant or obtain an exemption for a group of persons sharing a common characteristic from a potential <u>liability</u>.

To justify" as in justifiable homicide means to "vindicate" or show the justice in the particular conduct. Thus, <u>society</u> approves of the purpose or motives underpinning some actions or the consequences flowing from them- the behavior cannot be approved but some excuse may be found in the characteristics of the defendant from a <u>mental illness</u>.

An excuse relates to the <u>status</u> or <u>capacity</u> (or lack of it) in the accused. "To exculpate" means to free a particular individual from <u>culpability</u> after he or she has caused loss or damage.

Outline Overview: The Tithes

1st Tithing was done before the Law The Law was a shadow only: Abraham paid tithes to Melchizedek (Genesis 14:20, Heb. 7:1-2) Jacob paid tithes and was promised to be blessed (Genesis 28:10:22) Tithing was continued as a practice before the law(Genesis 28:15-22)

2nd Tithes & Offering: God has made it possible for every Christian to prosper financially. The channel by which He blesses His people is through TITHES and OFFERINGS. Tithing is far more than a cliché to help replenish the church's coffers and keep the ecclesiastical wheels turning. It is rather an opportunity for personal Christian growth and a systematic way of giving to the church.

Matthew 23:23 (KJV) : Jesus endorsed encouraged tithing (Matt. 23:23). and demands more of us (Luke 12:48). ²³ Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier *matters* of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

3rd It was practiced 430 years before the law (<u>Gen. 14:20; 28:22; Heb. 7:1-11</u>). **4th Tithing In the New Testament:** 1. Christ taught it (<u>Mt. 23:23; Lk. 11:42; cp. Mt. 5:20</u> with <u>Lk. 18:11-12</u>; see <u>Mt. 10:10; Lk. 10:7-8</u>). This was teaching for the kingdom of heaven (<u>Mt. 11:11-14; Lk. 16:16</u>)

2. Paul Taught It: (1) Condemned sacrilege (<u>Rom. 2:22</u>), or robbing temples (<u>Mal. 3:8-10</u>) and using holy things (<u>Lev. 27</u>)

- (2) Teachers to be paid (<u>Gal. 6:6</u>) (3) God ordained support of ministers (<u>1Cor. 9:7-14</u>; <u>1Tim. 6:17-18</u>)
- (3) Christians to give as God prospers them (1Cor. 16:2)

(44) Melchisedec priesthood is eternal and must be supported by children of Abraham (<u>Heb. 6:20; 7:1-11,17,21</u>)

(6) Children of Abraham in faith must walk in his steps (<u>Rom. 4:12; Heb. 7</u>)

(7) Tithing is proof of obedience and appreciation of God's blessings (<u>Rom.</u> 4:12; <u>Heb. 7:6-10; 1Cor. 9:7-14; 1Tim. 6:17-18; cp. Mal. 3:8-10; Prov. 3:9-10;</u> <u>Gen. 14:20; Dt. 8:10-20</u>)

5th Blessings of Tithing:

- 2. God's house will not lack (Mal. 3:10).

3. God's ministers will not lack (<u>1Cor. 9:7-14</u>; <u>1Tim. 5:17-18</u>; <u>Neh. 13:10</u>; <u>Mal. 3:8-10</u>).

4. Material spiritual blessings (Mal. 3:8-10 Prov. 3:9-10; 2Chr. 31 Neh. 13)
